A.Kadir Dökmeci received his medical degree from the Ankara University School of Medicine (AUSM) in 1971 and qualified as a gastroenterologist in 1978.

He has studied ultrasonography, ERCP as well as clinical hepatology in the Department of Internal Medicine at the Chiba University School of Medicine in Japan from Feb. 1979 to July 1981 for 2.5 years.

He was subsequently appointed as associate professor in 1982 and as a professor in 1988 and served as chief of Department of Internal Medicine and as a chief of Department of Gastroenterolgy at AUSM from 1993 to 2000.

Prof. Dökmeci has been a visiting professor at the Chiba University School of Medicine from 1988 to 1989 and at the University of California, Irvine in 2003.
